While working as a projectionist in a porn cinema in Central London during the 1980s, Bob Mazzer began photographing on the tube during his daily commute, creating irresistibly joyous pictures alive with humour and humanity.

"Every day I travelled to King's Cross and back. Coming home late at night, it was like a party and I felt like the tube was mine and I was there to take the pictures." - Bob Mazzer.

The quality and cultural significance of this collection has seen Mazzer establish himself as one of the 21st Century's key documenters of London life. The exhibited work is made all the more unique by the fact that it lay unseen for so long and that it comprises part of a unique 40 year project that can never be repeated. There is something timeless about how Mazzer has captured his subjects in such a personal, intimate and humane manner in such an unlikley environment.
